## Enviroment

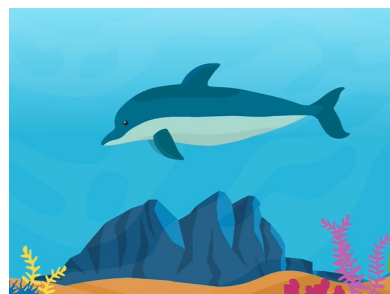
### Prior Knowledge:

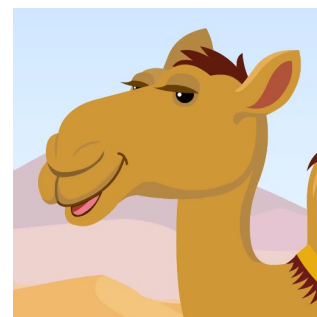
