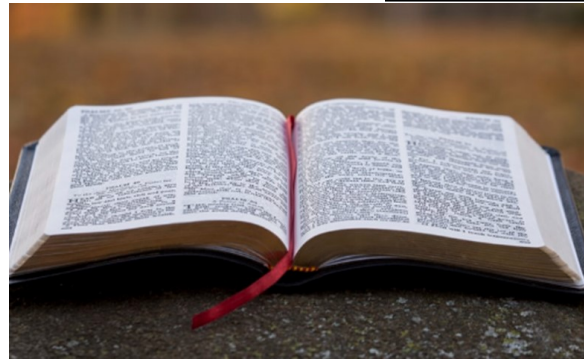


RE- What is the 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings?

Key Vocabulary

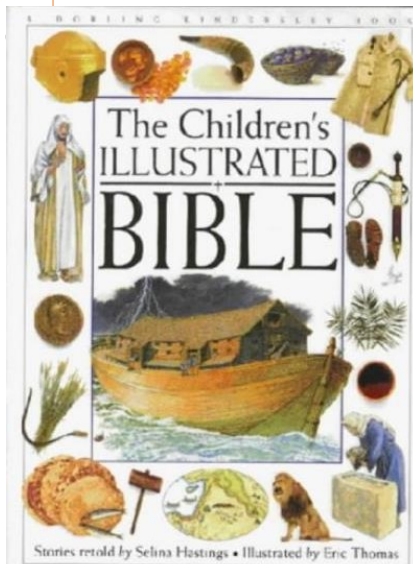
Tier 1: Church, God, Jesus, Vicar, The Bible, prayer, praise, thanksgiving
