Nursery & Reception –

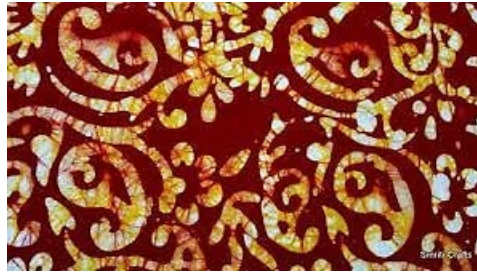
Experiments with blocks, colours and marks.
