Prior Knowledge

Nursery & Reception – Exploring colours and making marks while using lines to make drawings.


Year 1 - Use sketch pencils to make drawings. Explore the different shades and marks pencils make.

Year 2 - Use drawing pens to make a drawing (fine, medium, broad) Explore the different marks the pens make.

Year 3 - Make three dimensional drawings – pyramids.

Year 4 - Create movement in drawings and make drawings to music.

Lesson 6: I can create a final piece using learnt techniques and review my work.


