

Lesson 5: I can point out some things that are the same and some things that are different between how Hindus live in my area and in India.


Lesson 6: I can talk about some examples of people with different beliefs (e.g. class, in school, in local area, on TV) and what I think is good about people being different.

Lesson 7: I can explain what it is like to be a Hindu in Britain today.




## My Composite Knowledge:
