Prior Knowledge:

They have learnt the musical pulse depends on the speed of the music and have found and copied the pulse by clapping, clicking, jumping or hopping along.

Lesson 5: Why Don't You by (Dance/Big Band) by Gramophonedzie. Listen, appraise and discuss mash up music.



Lesson 6: Oye Como Va (Latin/Jazz) by Santana- Round And Round—prepare for the end of unit performance.

I will learn what style of music means- a way of expressing something that is a characteristic of a person or group of people.


My Powerful Knowledge:
