Lesson 5: I can explain how Christians believe people felt at the time of Jesus' death.

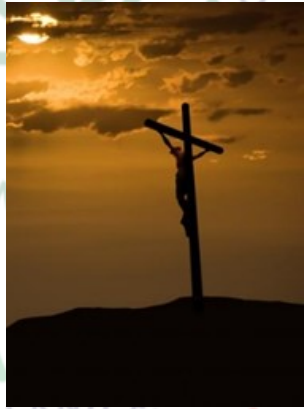
Lesson 6: I can explain why Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'.
