Jubliee Interviews

Many of you will know Martin Pailthorpe, editor of the local 'Nympton News'. Martin came in to Class 2 to run a session last week about interviewing. He is making a compilation of short video interviews with people from the community who remember the Coronation as part of the village's Jubilee celebrations. We would like to ask the children in Class 2 to join this initiative and conduct their own interviews with members of their family/the local community. The children have been set this project as home learning and we encourage them to participate.

The interviews can be filmed on a smartphone or i-pad or similar. If this is not possible, it is fine for the interviews to be written. Examples of questions that Martin ran through with the children are as follows (the children can of course ask further/alternative questions):

- How old were you at the time of the Coronation?
- Where were you living?
- Did you celebrate? How?
- Did you watch the Coronation on television?
- What do you remember about the queen?
- Were there street parties?
- Was war rationing still in place and did this impact what you ate?

Martin has left us a tripod to use if required, that takes an i-phone or similar. If you'd like to borrow this, please ask you child to pop and see Susie and she will organise this for them.
