Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Visit to Exmoor Zoo Monday 27th March 2023

To enhance our upcoming topic of Science of 'Animals including Humans' we have arranged a visit to Exmoor Zoo where the children will have first-hand experience of seeing the animals. We'll be met off the coach and given a short welcome and briefing with important instructions – this is delivered outdoors and includes updates on recent zoo animal news!

One of their trained educators will meet us during our visit at an enclosure to talk to pupils, introduce the animals and link to our classroom topic. They will bring along an interesting artefact or two from their amazing education collection (wet weather options are available).

We will be travelling to Exmoor Zoo by coach on Monday 27th March 2023, leaving the Parish Hall at 9.45am and returning by 3.00pm. We are also joining our peers from Year 1 at Winkleigh Primary School. Children should arrive at school at the normal time, and collected from school at the end of the normal school day.

Children will need to wear school uniform, trousers/ skirt/ leggings/ shorts that are weather appropriate, sensible shoes or boots and bring a waterproof coat. Exmoor Zoo can be cold and wet, so dressing for the weather will impact significantly on the children's enjoyment of the day.

They will also need a healthy packed lunch (no glass bottles, fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate bars please) and plenty to drink. If you would like school to provide a packed lunch please indicate this on the Gateway. Your child's belongings and lunch need to fit into a small ruck sack style bag that they are able to carry for themselves.

The cost of this visit to each child is £10.00. This is less than the actual cost involved, thanks to sharing the transport with Winkleigh Primary School plus using funds raised by sales from last year's Christmas cards.

We have to carefully cost every trip, and this does mean that our costing rely upon every child participating. If we do not receive full contributions for all pupils this visit will not be able to take place. If your circumstances are such that you are unable to pay this contribution, please contact the school to discuss this in confidence.

A payment request has been set up on the Gateway, please log in to give your consent, state home or school packed lunch, and make payment by Monday 20th March 2023.
