Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing today to clarify procedures around Covid/suspected cases of Covid in school-age children and school staff.

There is no longer any requirement to test staff or children nor for them to isolate or stay off school for a certain period The government guidelines are as follows:

Your child should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people if they have symptoms and they either:

- · have a high temperature
- · do not feel well enough to go to school, college or childcare, or do their normal activities

They can go back to school, college or childcare when they feel better or do not have a higher temperature.

If your child has mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat or mild cough, and they feel well enough, they can go to school, college or childcare.

Children have missed out on so much time in school over the past couple of years; it's very important that they are in school unless they are not well enough to attend.
