A note from the Head

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you had a restful break. It has been lovely to welcome the children back this week, and as always they have settled back into school routines and learning so well. We have an exciting term ahead of us with lots of trips and sporting activities planned. We are pleased to welcome Mrs Cornwall and Miss Phillips to the team, we hope you have both settled in.

In light of the recent online safety bill there are many new aspects which are set to further protect children online, one of which is making social media companies legally responsible for keeping children and young people safe including enforcing age limits and age checking measures.

We really would urge you to be highly vigilant to what your children are accessing online and to see below the recommendations for the ages to use various apps and online platforms.



We have heard lots about the presents that children received for Christmas and many children, of all ages, will have received gifts such as tablets, phones and other devices that will enable them to access the internet and create and share images for the first time, or an 'upgrade' on their current device(s) to make this even more available and accessible. Equally, many children will have spent a great amount of time online over the Christmas break including time exploring aspects such as Artificial Intelligence.

We are finding that more and more of our time is being taken up investigating and trying to resolve issues from online activity outside of school between children. We will of course continue to ensure that online safety is a high priority, however as a Federation we cannot police what happens on devices within the home environment.

Are you entitled?

If your circumstances have changed and you are now in receipt of one or more of the following:

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based jobseekers' allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

You may be eligible for pupil premium funding for Winkleigh Primary School, which entitles your child/ren to receive Free School Meals.
