Prior Knowledge

Year 2: What is the good news Christians believe Jesus brings? Who do Christians say made the world?

Year 4: What is the 'trinity' and why is it important for Christians? Why do Christians call the day Jesus died "Good Friday"? For Christians, when Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?

Year 5: What does it mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving? Why do Christians believe Jesus was the Messiah? Christians and how to live: "What would Jesus do?" What matters most to Humanists and Christians?

Year 6: What do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people? For Christians, what kind of king is Jesus? Creation and science: conflicting or complementary? Why do some people believe in God and some people not?
