**RE: Year 1 Educational Visit to Northam Burrows**

We have planned a visit to the beach at Northam Burrows on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> May. The children are learning about sculpture in Art this half term and will be learning about beach safety, Grace Darling and the RNLI in History lessons after the half term break. This trip will support both aspects of the curriculum. We will be taking part in a special beach sculpture workshop and will be meeting the RNLI lifeguards for a special talk and demo on the beach. After lunch we will also have an ice-cream from the Hockings van before we head back home!

Children will travel to Northam Burrows by coach from Winkleigh Primary School. We will be leaving around 9.15am and we will be back before the end of the school day.

All children will need to wear their school uniform and wear sensible shoes. They will also need a waterproof coat and suncream/sunhat if the weather is warm. For the sculpture session, we have each been asked to bring a bucket and spade along if possible. Please can these be named.

Children will need a packed lunch, a healthy mid-morning snack and a drink. (No glass bottles, fizzy drinks, chocolate bars or sweets please.) A school packed lunch can be requested.

The cost of this trip is £7.00 per child. We have been able to subsidise this trip with fundraising by Friends of Winkleigh. We have to carefully cost every trip and this does mean that our costings rely upon every child participating. If your circumstances are such that you are unable to pay this contribution, please contact the school to discuss this in confidence.

A payment request has been set up on the School Gateway, please login to give consent and pay your contribution by Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2024. Please state on the Gateway if your child will be bringing a packed lunch from home or if they require a school packed lunch.
