- We will buy glow toys again this time as an additional fundraiser.
- Covid risk assessment to be done (Suzie to help) and need to buy sanitizer.
- Ask parents to send in donations for a hamper, and Rachel to sell tickets on the night.
- Entry price to increase to £4 per person over 3 years old. Will sell tickets in advance this year (discounted rate of £3.50) by BACS or by sending money into the school letterbox.
- Donation Bucket to be put at the exit to catch any additional generosity!
- Ask the YFC to Marshall.

Mother's Day presents – we still have lots left over from 2020, so it would be good to try to use these next year.

Father's Day – to look at nearer the time.

Dare to be different – a really easy fundraiser – will look at doing in the summer term.
